## This funding will be used to

- Develop and deliver programs to meet the demand of schools who are seeking a learning experience outside the classroom. Many schools are unable to access JWEEC programs due to excessive demand and increased regional growth. JWEEC policy is to assist each school to deliver the best learning experience for their students.
- JWEEC will be able to provide an extra 12 days of outdoor learning experiences for over 300 students that are currently on a waiting list to be programmed.

## Our initiatives include

- Employing a teacher to deliver programs to schools that were previously unaccommodated on centre calendar.
- Teacher to provide instruction for programs not met in original calendar bookings – onsite, offsite and incursion programs
- Training and inservicing relief teachers to be able to teach highly specialised classes in various outdoor environments. .

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Increasing learning experiences for more than 300 students
- Embedding experiential learning and Pedagogy of Place to more than 300 students
- Costs include 12 days of TRS
- JWEEC will provide all training and inservice costs for teacher.
